POSITION: Tenure-track position as an Assistant/Associate Professor in Secondary Science Education.

RESPONSIBILITIES: Teach graduate and undergraduate courses in Secondary Science Education; supervise internships and practica; advise graduate and undergraduate students; conduct and publish independent research; direct graduate students research; and develop proposals for extramural funding. The Department of Curriculum and Teaching is a supportive and collaborative academic environment.

REQUIREMENTS/ QUALIFICATIONS:

Required - Earned doctorate in Secondary Science Education, or closely related field, with background in science is required if appointment is ranked assistant professor; at least three years of successful experience teaching in U.S. schools, grades 9-12.

Desired - Evidence of superior teaching; an established record of or a strong potential for research and publication in refereed journals; demonstrated skill in the application of technology for teaching; demonstrated experience working well as a member of a professional group; record of seeking and acquiring external funding.

RANK AND SALARY: Assistant/Associate Professor (tenure track) at a salary commensurate with experience and other qualifications. Nine-month contract.

APPLICATION PROCESS: Send letter of application, resume, official undergraduate and graduate transcripts, and three letters of recommendation to address below. Candidate selected for this position must be able to meet eligibility requirements to work in the U.S. at the time the appointment is scheduled to begin and must be able to communicate effectively in English. Screening will begin on November 9, 2007, and will continue until the position is filled.
